Biographical Note

Maurice B. Jewett was a life long resident of the Laconia/Winnisquam area. He was a member of the 1917 graduating class of the University of New Hampshire. He is listed in the Laconia directories for much of the 20th century as a clerk with his address being 13 Pearl Street. A search of the Social Security Death Index gives his possible birth and death dates as 1896-1980.

Scope and Content Note

The collection is comprised of 118 letters (1 box) to and from MBJ and his family who lived in the Laconia/Winnisquam area and 15 photos of MBJ as a soldier. The letters start off at Fort Devens, Massachusetts and continue on from France and cover the years 1918-1920.
